January is National Blood Donor Month

Bonfils Blood Center collected more than 217,000 units of blood in 2006 and needs 4,350 donors each week to meet the needs of our community in 2007. By making a plan to donate blood this January, you can save and enhance the lives of up to three patients—including helping kids with cancer feel better or saving the life of someone in a car accident.

The winter months are a difficult time to maintain the community blood supply, with blood donations declining up to 20 percent due to holiday activities, bad weather and cold and flu season. To thank you for your life-saving gift, **donors who give blood between now and Saturday, January 27, 2007, will receive a 2007 Bonfils Blood Center wall calendar** to make it easy to plan your yearlong life-saving commitment to donate blood in 2007. Did you know you can donate whole blood every 56 days, up to six times per year?

January is also National Blood Donor Month and Bonfils recognizes and thanks our nearly 120,000 blood donors who continue to make a difference in our community by donating blood.

COMMITMENT TO OUR Community

Thanks to the unwavering support of our blood donors, blood drive hosts, financial contributors, volunteers and healthcare and community partners, Bonfils Blood Center once again ended the year with an extensive list of successes.

Bonfils, which exists to provide a safe, adequate and efficiently produced blood supply, collected a record-breaking 217,681 units of blood at Bonfils' nine community donor centers and more than 3,600 blood drives hosted by nearly 1,400 businesses, civic groups and faith-based organizations.

These blood donations supported patients in need in our community and beyond. Our generous blood donors lent much needed support to the U.S. Military at various times throughout the year by giving hundreds of blood donations. Bonfils' contract to support the military's wartime blood needs was renewed in late 2006 allowing Bonfils to retain its role as one of only eight community blood centers across the nation to supply blood products to the military when called upon.

Bonfils' Colorado Marrow Donor Program closed out 2006 by facilitating 35 blood stem cell or marrow

matches and four cord blood matches for patients suffering from blood-related diseases. The program was also successful in placing more than 2,600 potential marrow donors in Colorado on the National Marrow Donor Registry.

Our subsidiaries also thrived in 2006 – Hemo-Net, an application service provider, added three new clients; Laboratories at Bonfils launched a newly-designed Web site and continues to be an industry leader in laboratory transplant medicine; and Bonfils Blood Center Foundation secured more than \$500,000 to support the completion of the Sterling Community Donor Center, the acquisition of a new bloodmobile and more.

Bonfils Blood Center is poised to achieve more accomplishments in 2007. As the steward of Colorado's community blood supply, Bonfils will continue to foster relationships with all those who work with us to support our community and its patients. We sincerely thank you for your commitment to our life-saving mission and welcome you to continue in our journey of advancing healthcare and saving lives.



BREAKS ATTENDANCE RECORDS

Nearly 2,900 people, including 597 first-time donors, came to INVESCO Field at Mile High on October 24 to make a life-saving play at Drive for Life IX. Bonfils collected more than 1,800 units of blood to support patients in need. More than 230 people also joined Bonfils' Colorado Marrow Donor Program, offered at Drive for Life for the first time this year, to support patients in need of stem cell/marrow transplants.

Bonfils Blood Center and the Denver Broncos embarked on a new rivalry for Drive for Life IX by competing pint for pint against the Houston Texans. Broncos fans won the challenge with the Houston Texans, in partnership with Gulf Coast Regional Blood Center, hosting 661 blood donors.

"Bonfils is so proud to have closed out this year's Drive for Life with record-breaking numbers and more lives saved than any other year," said Jessica Maitland, vice president of marketing and community operations. "Tremendous results like this would not have been possible without the support of so many community-minded donors and the ongoing dedication of the Denver Broncos."

Donors enjoyed the opportunity to meet Denver Broncos players, cheerleaders and alumni including Jake Plummer, Rod Smith, John Lynch, Nate Jackson, Jay Cutler, Karl Mecklenburg, Dominique Foxworth and more. Donors also received stadium food, a free event t-shirt and lapel pin and raffle prizes from area businesses.

Drive for Life has hosted more than 17,000 blood donors in its nine years and we look forward to seeing you in the huddle at Drive for Life X in October.

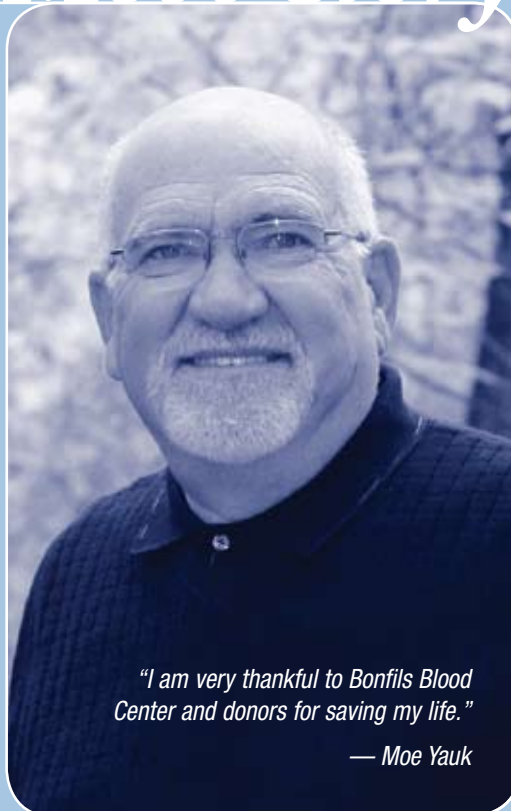
Moe's Story

INCREASES FREQUENCY OF MOBILE BLOOD DRIVES.

A recent evaluation of Bonfils' operations in Pueblo revealed that not only is the number of donors in the area increasing, but more and more donors are choosing to give blood at mobile blood drives. Currently, Bonfils hosts more than 200 mobile blood drives annually with businesses, civic groups and faith-based organizations in Pueblo County.

In order to continue to make blood donation convenient, Bonfils has increased the number and capacity of blood drives to allow more flexibility in terms of hours and locations. Additionally, Saturday hours have been added at the donor

center in hopes of providing greater convenience for Bonfils' blood donors who prefer to donate at a fixed site location.

No matter whether you choose to donate at a mobile blood drive or at the Pueblo Community Donor Center, Bonfils encourages community members to schedule a donation appointment as walk-in availability may be limited. Bonfils' Colorado Marrow Donor Program Inaugural Food and Marrow Drive a Success

Last November, Bonfils' Colorado Marrow Donor Program (CMDP) teamed up with two local food banks – Food Bank of the Rockies and Community Food Share – to help stop hunger and to raise awareness for National Marrow Awareness Month. Throughout the month of November 169 individuals joined the National Marrow Donor Registry free of charge in exchange for donating non-perishable food items to help less fortunate families during the holiday season.

Those 169 people who recently joined the registry unite with more than 65,000 Coloradans who have committed to become blood stem cell or marrow donors in hopes of saving the lives of patients with blood-related diseases such as leukemia and lymphoma.

"We are pleased with the response to our first ever

food and marrow drive. Our community continually steps up to support one another whether in the form of fending off hunger locally or providing life-saving donations to patients all over the world," said Patty Owens, program manager of CMDP.

Each year, thousands of people in the United States are diagnosed with diseases for which a blood stem cell – more commonly known as marrow – transplant could be a cure. Approximately 70 percent of patients are unable to find a donor match within their family. Ethnically diverse patients have the greatest difficulty finding a suitable unrelated donor therefore recruiting new and ethnically diverse stem cell donors is key to the ongoing success of the program.

Healthy individuals between the ages of 18 and 60 may join the registry at any of Bonfils' nine community donor centers or mobile blood drives. To register, potential donors will complete a health history and consent form and a small sample of cells will be collected for initial testing. The CMDP also continually seeks volunteers interested in coordinating ethnic-focused marrow registration drives at their churches, schools, businesses or other community organizations. Tax Tips

Pension Protection Act - The newly enacted *Pension Protection Act of 2006 (PPA)* provides special tax provisions for benefactors* who have reached age 70 ½ and want to make a charitable gift to benefit an eligible charity by using proceeds from their IRA or Roth IRA.

Through December 31, 2007, benefactors can make a tax-free gift directly from their retirement plan trustee or plan administrator to Bonfils Blood Center Foundation, a 501(c)(3) charitable organization. For some taxpayers, the provisions in the *PPA* can benefit Bonfils and may avoid some or all of the ordinary income tax on the mandated distribution from their IRA or Roth IRA.

Receipt Required - Beginning in taxable years after August 17, 2006, benefactors will need to substantiate cash gifts to a charity via a canceled check, bank record or receipt. Bonfils Blood Center provides each financial contributor with a thank you letter receipt, acknowledging your generosity and compassion and which satisfies this tax requirement.

GRANTS AWARDED

Bonfils Blood Center has recently been the recipient of two grants to support our mission of saving and enhancing lives, including:

The Helen K. and Arthur E. Johnson Foundation awarded Bonfils a \$25,000 grant toward the purchase of a new bloodmobile to continue to improve our ability to make blood donation convenient for donors.

Each year, approximately 60 percent of blood donations are collected at mobile blood drives. This year, Bonfils plans to conduct more than 3,500 blood drives around the state and nearly 30 percent of those will take place on a bloodmobile. The useful life of a bloodmobile is 12 years and our 1995 coach is nearing the end of its lifecycle. This grant will go a long way in helping Bonfils secure a new bloodmobile to continue our life-saving work.

The Colorado Avalanche Community Fund, a Fund of The Robert R. McCormick Tribune Foundation has awarded \$5,000 for Bonfils' Cord Blood Services program.



In partnership with Denver metro area hospitals, Bonfils began its Cord Blood Services program to increase the possibility of a suitable match for patients in need of a marrow transplant. Umbilical cords, typically discarded after the birth of a child, contain rare and valuable life-saving properties. Cord blood can be cryogenically frozen and the stem cells, which contribute to the body's ability to renew and repair its tissues, can be used to treat patients suffering from blood-related diseases. Once tested, cord blood units are placed in a nationwide inventory to be readily available for life-saving transplants. Stem cells from cord blood units display characteristics that reduce the risk of infection, cell rejection and complication for a recipient.

In Colorado, one in 330 children is diagnosed with cancer before their 20th birthday. For these children and other patients, a stem cell transplant often provides their best hope for survival and this grant helps Bonfils support these needs.
